

May 25, 1938

The last meeting of the Student Council was held Wed. May 25, at 4:00 in M 108. The meeting was called to order by Paul. Roll was called and minutes were read and approved. First discussed the [key] and pin situation. All those who wished pins signed up. Next discussed the jacket situation. Paul sent a registered letter to the company, Regal Jacket Company, over a week ago, but he has received no answer. He had also sent \$0.59 in stamps to the Post Office in Rocky River, Ohio, but they replied that the jackets had been sent back here.

Motion: That the council pay \$24.65 for senior jackets. Seconded by Ellen Sorenson. The motion carried. Introduction of new Council Members and those that hold over from last year. Harriet Beyer proposed that any money the council has left over be turned over to a Lounge Committee. Read a list of the [ ] of the lounge. At the present time there is \$ 164.32 in the Council Treasury. Motion by Henderson May: That after all of the bills have been paid the balance of the money should be given to a committee from the Student Council. Seconded by Harriet Beyer. The Motion Carried.
