

## Legislative Bylaws

### Article 3. Authorities, Powers and Responsibilities

#### Section 2. SGA Internal Committees

C. The ~~Programs and Recognition~~ Membership and Outreach Committee shall have the following authorities, powers, and responsibilities:

i. To abide by and support the Student Government Association Constitution, Bylaws, and other governing documents.

ii. To review, research, interview on a committee level, and preliminarily confirm Presidential appointments for legislative vacancies, reporting decision to the Assembly prior to the commencement of debate.

iii. To designate a member to attend interviews being conducted by the President of the Student Body for legislative vacancies.

~~iv~~iii. To assist in the recruitment and selection of candidates for Presidential appointments.

v. To preliminarily review and pass recommendation to Assembly and the Executive Committee for all charges of Impeachment.

~~legislative-vi~~ vi. Serve as informal facilitators, to successfully resolve conflicts between SGA members without a formal Performance Review Hearing.

vii. Maintain SGA Public Bulletin Boards located in Academic building for content timeliness and appropriateness.

~~viii. iv~~ iv. To coordinate ~~programs for internal Association participation~~ all internal programs of the Association, with the exception of Passing of the Gavel, Summer Retreat, Fall Retreat and Winter Retreat.

ix. Provide support to the Student Body Executive Director for Passing of the Gavel, Summer, Fall, and Winter Retreat.

x. Provide support to the Secretary of Programming for external programming upon request of the Secretary.

xi. Provide support to all Senators working on external programs with the assistance of the Secretary of Programming.

xii. To preliminary approval of all Co-Sponsorship requests from external organizations.

xiii. To maintain contact with Alumni members of the Association.
