Amendment to the Legislative Bylaws to Change the Procedure for Speaking Privileges
WHEREAS, The Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State University;
WHEREAS, Student Government Association's own constitution reads that "[Students have] a democratic student government in which each student shall have an equal right to participate;"
WHEREAS, the Student Government Association of Illinois State University values the input of its own constituency and student body;
WHEREAS, Roberts Rules, which govern how Student Government Assembly meetings are run, uses vague language that has led multiple associations to interpret whether non-members of the Student Government Association are allowed to speak during assembly meetings;
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this bylaw amendment codifies the students' right and ability to speak during Student Government assemblies;
THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the specific changes to be made are listed as follows (elements bolded below are for clarity by emphasis and shall not be bolded in the actual document);
Article IV, Section 5. Subsection B
B. Speaking privileges may be granted to any other <b>person</b> , <b>assembly member or not</b> , with two thirds (2/3) <b>one-thirds</b> (1/3) approval of the Assembly membership present and voting at any time during a meeting.
