4 Bill Approving the Student Elections Code

5  
6 WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State University;

7  
8 WHEREAS, it is the goal and duty of the Student Government Association to ensure that their constituents are well represented  
9 and elected in a fair and judicious manner;

10  
11 WHEREAS, the Student Elections Code is a document that has been restructured to make the election process for the Student  
12 Government Association and the Association of Residence Halls of Illinois State University more straightforward and clearly  
13 defined;

14  
15 WHEREAS, the Student Government Association commends the SEC Commission on their work and approves the Student  
16 Elections Code;

17  
18 WHEREAS, the Executive Director will remain part of the election process due to the nature of the position and the governing  
19 documents of the Student Government Association;

20  
21 WHEREAS, the Black Student Union elections will be conducted separately and will not be overseen by the Student Elections  
22 Committee;

23  
24 WHEREAS; the Student Elections Committee is charged with establishing the election and campaigning dates unless the Student  
25 Government Association has determined said dates before the appointment of the Student Elections Committee;

26  
27 WHEREAS, the candidate debates will now include Student Trustee when there are two or more candidates for the position, the  
28 Committee will be charged with formatting and publicizing the event;



30 WHEREAS, Registered Student Organizations are no longer allowed to endorse a candidate and must remain impartial in the  
31 election process as endorsements will no longer be a part of the election process;



33 WHEREAS, in sanctioning a party in violation of the Student Elections Code, the Student Elections Committee has full  
34 discretion in determining the degree of offense by division there will be a clearly defined table of repercussions to coincide with  
35 the offense;

37 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association approves the newly revised Student  
38 Elections Code;
