 20 pm and reopen once a consensus is reached but no later than 7:30am;

22 WHEREAS, the '09-'10 SGA Winter Lock-In will cost approximately \$300.00 with the funds going to
 23 catering from Jimmy Johns, refreshments for the night, and awards for the superlatives;

25 WHEREAS, the '09-'10 SGA Winter Lock-In will be mandatory for all members of the Association and
 26 Ex-Officios and ELPs are strongly encouraged to attend;
