Resolution approving the Student Fee Budget for FY 2011

 WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State University;

WHEREAS, one of the responsibilities of the Student Government Association is to give their recommendation on the budget for student fees;

WHEREAS, the priorities for FY 2011 accomplished through reallocation are: create/develop late night and alternative programming – *Dean of Students/Campus Recreation/ Bone Student Center*, Implement new software solutions to address current and new department needs – *Campus Recreation/Disability Concerns/SAIT*, Engage underserved students – *Dean of Students*, Increase focus on staff and student multicultural competency – *Dean of Students*, Increase program and event risk management – *Dean of Students*, Become a more environmentally sustainable organization – *Dean of Students/SAIT*, Provide tiered learning experiences, including opportunities for high achieving students to mentor fellow students – *Dean of Students*, Cover appropriate contract increase for Nite Ride – *Nite Ride*, Increase Daily Vidette allocation by \$3,000 – *Daily Vidette*, Complete opening of SF&KR building in Spring 2011 – *Campus Recreation*, Implement changes in organizational chart to address new demands of facility – *Campus Recreation*, Bone Master Planning – *Bone Student Center*, Complete necessary repairs – *Bone Student Center*, Provide online alcohol assessment tool for first-year students – *Health Promotion and Wellness*, Expand and enhance psychiatric services – *Student Health Services*, Remodeling of existing space to address needs – *Student Health Services/Disability Concerns*, Accreditation – *Student Counseling Services*;

WHEREAS, the 2003 Board of Trustees Resolution on Student Fees allows for increase in fees for the following items: Salary increase if approved by President Bowman – *Estimated at \$2.23 per credit hour*, Contractual agreements such as Redbird Ride & Nite Ride Programs – *Activity Fee increase of \$.77 per credit hour*, Student Referendum to build SF&KR Facility – *Facility Fee increase of \$2.00 per credit hour*;

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association has made outreach to many students, informing them and listening to their opinions on the budget review recommendation;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Assembly recommends the current budget review proposal for FY 2011;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Student Body President Spialek and Secretary of Student Fees Cahanin will present this information to Vice President of Student Affairs Adams and Vice President of Finance and Planning Layzel.
