7 WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State
8 University;

10 WHEREAS, Campus safety, communication, and school pride are all goals for the 2009-2010 Student
11 Government Association;

13 WHEREAS, building an uplifting, encouraging, and supportive environment for all students of all
14 backgrounds helps create a safe campus environment;

16 WHEREAS, *Diversity Week: The Waves of Change* is scheduled for April 5th-April 9th;

18 WHEREAS, only one of the sixteen events scheduled is currently being monetarily sponsored by Student
19 Government Association;

21 WHEREAS, The President’s Office has committed 500 dollars to the “Soundtrack for a Revolution”
22 screening;

24 WHEREAS, an anticipated 468 dollars is expected to be contributed from the MECCPAC: Dean of
25 Students Diversity Initiative Fund;

27 WHEREAS, an additional 400 dollars is necessary to cover the remaining expenses including screening
28 fee and room costs;

30 WHEREAS, the screening will be scheduled for Friday, April 9th at 1pm in the Prairie Room;

32 WHEREAS, the screening is focused on the Civil Rights Movement and the influence of music during the
33 movement.

35 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Assembly of the Student Government Association authorizes the
36 Student Government Association’s co-sponsorship of “Soundtrack for a Revolution” on Friday, April 9th.

38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Assembly of the Student Government Association directs Secretary
39 of Diversity Affairs Hall to make sure all logistical and planning arrangements are made.

41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Assembly of the Student Government Association directs Secretary
42 of Public Relations Brewer and Secretary of Information Technology Olson to work with Secretary of
43 Diversity Affairs Hall in publicizing this event.

45 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs Student
46 Body Executive Director Krug to work with Advisor Olshak to ensure that all appropriated funds are
47 allocated and the logistical arrangements are made accordingly.
