Resolution Authorizing the Co-Sponsorship of Homecoming

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State University;

WHEREAS, promoting school pride is a goal of the 2009-2010 Student Government Association;

WHEREAS, Red Alert and the University Program Board have provided the Student Government Association with opportunities to promote school pride through the co-sponsorship of Homecoming 2009;

WHEREAS, Homecoming Week will take place between Monday, October 12 and Saturday, October 17, 2009;

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Student Government Association must approve all funding requests over the sum of \$500;

WHEREAS, the Finance and Allocation Committee approved the request of \$1,400 from the SGA Operational Budget submitted by Secretary of Programs Green on behalf of the Student Government Association Executive Committee and recommends the formal appropriation of Operational Budget funding;

WHEREAS, giving \$1,400 will provide the Student Government Association with the opportunity and recognition of co-sponsorship at the selected events during Homecoming 2009;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Student Government Association authorizes the Co-Sponsorship of Homecoming;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association accepts the recommendation of the Finance and Allocation Committee and approves a \$1,400 allocation for the funding request for the Co-Sponsorship with Red Alert and the University Program Board for Homecoming 2009;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs the Student Body Executive to work with Advisor Olshak to ensure that all appropriate funds are allocated and that all logistical arrangements are made accordingly;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs Secretary of Programs Green to work with the Secretary of the Assembly McMahon to transmit signatures copies of this resolution to Red Alert and the University Program Board.
