 5 WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State

 8 WHEREAS, promoting School Pride is a goal of the 2010-2011 Student Government Association
 9 Administration;

 11 WHEREAS, finals week is a stressful time for the student body and a stress relief program promoting
 12 school spirit would be a perfect way to relieve stress as opposed to other detrimental activities;

 14 WHEREAS, Milner Library is main place where students congregate to study and complete final projects
 15 the Sunday before finals week;

 17 WHEREAS, WZND student radio station can perform music for a ten minute period in which students
 18 can congregate in the Milner Library main lobby for a ten minute dance/study break session;

 20 WHEREAS, upon request approval, Reggie Red Bird, paid for by Milner Library, will lead students into
 21 the Milner Library Lobby to start the event and lead students out to end the event;

 23 WHEREAS, the "Kickin' Off Finals Week with Club Milner" event will be a stress relieving activity for
 24 students to participate in at the start of finals;

 26 WHEREAS, this event will occur on Sunday, December 12th, 2010 in the main lobby of Milner Library
 27 from 10:00-10:10 p.m.;;

 29 WHEREAS, this event will be a collaboration with Milner Library, SGA, and WZND on the student's
 30 behalf to create a positive tradition for finals week at Illinois State University;

 32 WHEREAS, the name of this event is tentative, and may be changed upon creative collaboration;

 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Student Government Association approves the request for \$75 for
 35 advertising materials and use of WZND radio.

 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Student Government Association authorizes the participation in the
 38 "Kickin' Off Finals Week with Club Milner".

 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, it will be mandatory for the Programs and Recognition committee to
 41 attend and highly recommended for every member of the Association to attend this event.

 43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, one hour of chalking will be mandatory, based on whether
 44 conditions, for the Programs and Recognition committee.

 46 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs
 47 Secretary of Public Relations Robles, with collaboration with Senator McMahon, to publicize the
 48 event by creating a Facebook event, and other social media advertising.
