 3 Resolution Authorizing Student Government Association Purchase of Safety Whistles as Giveaways

 5 WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State
 6 University;

 8 WHEREAS, campus safety is a goal of the 2010-2011 Student Government Association Administration;

 10 WHEREAS, the 2010-2011 Student Government Association has allocated \$2,000 for promotional items
 11 to students;

 13 WHEREAS, there has been an increase in Illinois State University Crime Alerts that signify people being
 14 attacked, harmed, and/or robbed on or near campus;

 16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, giving students whistles will allow them to be heard by others in the
 17 area during an emergency;

 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, 500 “coaching and official’s” whistles can be purchased for \$301.03,
 20 including shipping and handling;

 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association accepts the
 23 recommendation of the Student Government Association Executive Committee and approves \$315.00 for
 24 the purchase of whistles as Student Government Association giveaways;

 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association will hand out the
 27 whistles between 9AM-3PM on Tuesday, November 9th, 2010 in the Schroeder Plaza;

 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, every member of the Student Government Association is required to
 30 attend the event for at least one hour;

 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this event can be used to complete Canvassing the Campus hours for the
 33 semester;

 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Secretary of Public Relations will be required to advertise this event,
 36 including a press release to the *Daily Vidette*, Facebook event, Student Government Association Twitter
 37 account, and Tumblr;

 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs Student
 40 Body Executive Director Martin to work with Advisor Olshak to ensure that all appropriated funds are
 41 allocated and the logistical arrangements are made accordingly.
