

Sponsor: Student Body President Owens, Senator Manno Resolution Endorsing a Reading and Review Week WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State University; WHEREAS, it is a goal of the 2011-2012 SGA administration to assess the needs of students and design and implement programs and services to respond to changing student needs; WHEREAS, a survey released by Student Government after Finals Week 2011 found students experienced very high stress levels during finals week and the week preceding finals week; WHEREAS, many studies have found that the unhealthy levels of stress students experience and the study habits that accompany the stress are counterproductive to educational retention and knowledge; WHEREAS, students have reported the administering of exams in the week preceding final exams week or other course components that contributes to the stress level of students; THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association endorses a reading and review period; THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the issue will be forward from Student government to the Academic Affairs committee to craft a policy that is reasonable and still maintains the integrity of academic freedom; THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Academic Affairs committee is requested to continually update the Assembly of the Student Government Association on matters relating to this issue.
