7 WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State  
8 University;

10 WHEREAS, communication is a pillar of the 2011-2012 Student Government Association  
11 Administration;

13 WHEREAS, promoting civic engagement and political participation are also goals of the 2011-2012  
14 Student Government Association Administration;

16 WHEREAS, December 1<sup>st</sup> of every year is internationally recognized as World AIDS Day;

17  
18 WHEREAS, HIV/AIDS has devastating consequences across the world;

19  
20 WHEREAS, awareness and prevention of HIV/AIDS domestically and internationally is important;

22 WHEREAS, The Student Health Services, The G-Spot, and Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc., have  
23 expressed interest in being a part of The Student Government Association's participation in World AIDS  
24 Day;

26 WHEREAS, continuing to build a strong relationship and partnering with university services is a goal of  
27 the 2011-2012 Student Government Association.

29 WHEREAS, no other student organization on campus is currently sponsoring a World AIDS day event;

30  
31 WHEREAS, the price to purchase and distribute Red Ribbon pins and information about HIV/AIDS is  
32 minimal;

34 WHEREAS, The Student Government Association, The G-Spot, and Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc.,  
35 will distribute red-ribbon pins and information in various academic buildings across campus between  
36 10am and 2 pm on Thursday, December 1<sup>st</sup>;

38 WHEREAS, The Student Health Service, The G-Spot, and Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc., will provide  
39 materials essential to this event;

41 WHEREAS, it will be highly recommended for each member of the association to participate for at least  
42 one hour;

44 WHEREAS, participation in this event can also be used to fulfill the semester requirements for  
45 Canvassing the Campus;

47 WHEREAS, The Student Body President, and Secretary of Diversity Affairs have expressed support for  
48 this program;

50 WHEREAS, the Student Government Association Executive committee has approved \$20 for the event;

52 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Student Government Association authorizes SGA’s sponsorship  
53 and participation in National AIDS Awareness Day.

55 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, an allocation of \$20 will cover the cost of red ribbons, and promotional  
56 materials;

58 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs the  
59 Secretary of Public Relations Gill and the Secretary of Information Technology Kraemer to work with  
60 Secretary of Diversity Affairs and Student Health Services to ensure the event is publicized.

62 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs Secretary  
63 of Diversity Affairs Mackins to make sure all logistical arrangements, including facility reservations, are  
64 made.

66 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs Secretary  
67 of Diversity Affairs to work with Executive Director Davis to ensure that all appropriated funds are  
68 allocated and the logistical arrangements are made accordingly.
