Resol ution Authorizing OCSA Fall Fundi ng

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is the official student governing body for Illinois State University;

WHEREAS, outreaching to off-campus students and improving off-campus living are enduring goals of the Student Government Association;

WHEREAS, the OCSA needs operational funding to be successful;

WHEREAS, OCSA's current relationship with SGA creates a conflict of interest which denies the maccess to the opportunity fund;

WHEREAS, SGA has provided funds to the OCSA on a regular basis in support of the organizational goals, in the past;

WHEREAS, currently, the 2012-2013 SGA has roughly \$25,000 in "Rollover and Reserve" Fundi ng— funds remaining from previous fiscal years – available to spend;

WHEREAS, the SGA Executive Committee has agreed to provide funding to OCSA for a table skirt, website fees, printing, and recruitment tools;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association approves the allocation of \$900 to the Off-Campus Student Association for the Fall of 2012;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Assembly of the Student Government Association directs the Student Body Executive Director to work with Advisor Davenport to promptly and properly transfer the allocated funds to the OCSA Dean of Students Registered Student Organization Account.
